This is the time of year that the board needs to consider a tentative general fund budget for the ensuing fiscal year. The required public hearing has been held and now the Board needs to act on the budget.

It was moved by Trustee Fought and supported those tee Kring to the IT RESOLVED that the Board adopt a Tentative General Fund Operating Budget in the aggregate amount of \$19,127,470 for the College's fiscal year startidgly 1, 2024,

Trustee Fought provided the following background:

Emmet County has received an allocation of \$6.49 million under the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund which is a program under the American Rescue Plan Act. The County Board of Commissioners has assigned \$500,000 to fund grants to Emmet County Action Group. The College's Child Care Initiative qualifies as an Action Group ther defense eligible for financial assistance under this Act.

The County has offered a grant to North Central Michigan College in the amount of \$50,000 for its Child Care InitiativeTo receive the grant, the College Board needs to approve tpage0-agreement that accompanies the grant. A copy of this agreement was included in the board packet The language of the agreement is standard detailing the responsibilities of both the College and County.

Trustee Fought moved and Trustee Pretty supported that North Central Michigan College approve the agreement between Emmet County and the College for the County grant to the College of \$50,000 for its Child Care Initiative.

The College Foundation is planning a capital campaign to assist in the financing of the CATEE project. To encourage donations, the Foundationdexeloped a schedule of naming opportunities for those donors inclined to make significant donations. For example, a donation of \$1,000,000 or better would give the donor the right to name the new tech building while a donation of \$500,000 or more would provide the donor the right to name the new Health Education and Science Center addition.
